BANK OPENED WITH PRAYER.

MOREHEAD, Ky., Jan. 3.—Rowan County's first bank, the Bank of Morehead, was opened to-day in an unusual but impressive manner. A large crowd assembled. Dr. L. P. V. Williams called the meeting to order. The Rev. L. E. Mann read psalms, after which he invoked the blessing of God to rest upon the institution. Appropriate addresses were made by James E. Clarke, J. G. White, W. A. Young, J. W. Riley, Z. T. Young, T. B. Tippet, and others.

There was a rush to deposit, and deposits amounting to \$40,000 were received the first day.
